- 4. Correspondence and Information Items:
 - a) Capital Project Updates:
 - Surface Treatment Completed
 - Gravel Resurfacing Completed
 - Asphalt Paving Completed
 - Lake Nosbonsing Shouldering September

The shouldering on Lake Nosbonsing Road should be completed by next week.

The Committee also discussed Derland Road and using equipment to pack down the stone as well as placing bicycle imprints on the bike lanes on Lake Nosbonsing Road.

b) Operational Updates:

• Edge Paving – September/October

Public Works will continue with edge paving through the fall. There was a bit of a learning curve, but it works well.

Brushing

Brushing will also continue through the fall as long as the weather cooperates. The Committee discussed removing the canopy that overhangs



a portion of South Shore Road.

• Safety Signs - September/October

The signs should be delivered soon. Sign locations are being determined.

• Miscellaneous

The Committee discussed consulting the public with regards to reducing the speed limit in some areas of the Municipality and the following resolution was passed.

THAT the Public Works and Infrastructure Committee recommends to Council that staff be directed to initiate public consultation with regards to reducing the speed limit on the following roads:

Guillemette Road - 50 km/h from 60 km/h

Lavigne Road – from 60 km/h to 50 km/h
MacPherson Drive – from 60 km/h to 50 km/h
Nosbonsing Park Road – from 60 km/h to 50 km/h
South Shore Road between Marina Road and the turnout at Lot 9 – from 60 km/h to 50 km/h
Quae Quae Road – from 70 km/h to 60 km/h
Waukegan Road – from 60 km/h from 50 km/h

CARRIED

The Committee discussed the landfill and the issue they are having with mattresses. This issue will be looked at before the next meeting. An amendment to the fees and charges by-law may be required.

c) Street Light Derland Road - Corbeil Intersection - Install Schedule October

The light should be repaired in October. The light issue at Corbeil Road and Lavigne Road will also be fixed.

d) Fire Update

The shell of the building should be delivered around the beginning of November. Public Works is doing all they can in-house.

The Committee discussed winter operations and ensuring the department is prepared.
