"Making a Difference" in the restoration and conservation of our natural resources in the East Ferris area for over 35 years the Nosbonsing Anglers and Hunter's President Paul Emile Perron was the presented Sportsperson of the Year Award, on Wednesday February 27th, by Ontario Federation of Anglers and Hunters (OFAH)- Zone D Vice Chair Gerry Geissler.

In 1983 Paul-Emile Perron rallied a group of like-minded community people to discuss the possibility of forming conservation-based hunting and fishing club for the Astorville area. In recognition of Paul Emile Perron's dedication, passion and accomplishments the club proudly endorsed and presented a submission to OFAH Zone D award process and as a result was selected to receive the Sportsperson of the Year award for Zone D and was further submitted to OFAH for consideration of the prestigious Gordon Blake Memorial Conservation Award for the province. We were recently advised that Paul Emile was selected as the winner of the Gordon Blake Memorial Conservation Award. Plans are now being finalized for a celebration in which Paul Emile will be presented his award. Numerous local dignitaries, press and representatives from OFAH will be in attendance to participate in this award ceremony.
