**Subject:** Request for Noise By-Law Exemption - Wedding Event on August 8th, 2026

Dear Clerk and Council Members,

I am writing to respectfully request a temporary exemption from By-law No. 2015-33 (Noise By-law) for a small private wedding event to be held within the Municipality of East Ferris.

The event is scheduled for Saturday, August 8, 2026, and will take place on B2 Perron Island on Lake Nosbonsing in Astorville from 4:00 PM until 12:00 AM. As part of the celebration, there will be music and amplified sound during the evening, which may exceed the allowable noise limits outlined in the by-law.

We recognize the importance of maintaining a peaceful environment for all residents and are committed to minimizing any potential disturbance. To that end, we will:

- Position speakers to direct sound away from neighboring properties where feasible
- Monitor and control sound levels throughout the event
- Notify nearby residents in advance of the event
- Ensure that all music and amplified sound cease promptly at 12:00 AM

This is a one-time event of personal significance, and we kindly request Council's consideration in granting an exemption for the specified date and time.

Please advise if there are any forms, fees, or additional information required to process this request. We are prepared to comply with any conditions that may be imposed.
