Dear Elected municipal officials:

My name is André Rochefort and I live at 186 Lavigne rd. I writing to you with some concerns I have about this quarry that is developing at Marcel Degagnes pit on Lavigne rd.

My understanding is that they will be going from 20,000 tons of material to 450,000 tons a year. (please correct me if I'm wrong) So that is from approximately 1000 trucks a year to 20,000 trucks a year. That is a reason for concern.

Also, on May 19th there was a blast like no other! I thought my neighbors house blew up! I ran outside to see what happened and other neighbours were out thinking the same thing. No one was notified about this blast and then found out it was going to happen every once in a while.

Why haven't we heard anything from the township about any of this?

How will this affect our roads?

Who will pay for the extra wear and tear on the roads?

What if our well water is affected?

How will the dust be kept down?

The few Trucks that already go by drive fast enough on our road, I can't imagine having 100x that now.

How can Marcel Degagne make such a big change with minimal information to the public?

This does not just concern Lavigne rd. residents, but affects all surrounding roads.
