Strategic Plan 2024-2027 Mini Update

I added a hit counter to the volunteer page to track visits from the homepage. The portal and accompanying software has processed 11.5 volunteer hours to date. Of the 9 volunteers that completed the application form, 2 have set up profiles on the website to manage their bookings. Recruitment will be ongoing organically from the website and we will start leveraging our other channels. I.e Facebook, Instagram, etc...

Work on the information page is starting with the map of businesses. I met with the committee, and some of the information still needs some editing. We should be in a position to launch it in December.

The strike at Canada Post has delayed the delivery of the paper newsletter. We had hoped to be able to send out two newsletters back to back, however this will not be the case for 2024.

The exhibit space in the library has been tidied and there are currently 2 artists with works on display. An artist expressed interest in maybe creating some prints of their work. I'll be looking into the logistics of doing so. I think this will open the door to further promote our Epson inkjet printer!

A dedicated page for Artists has been set up on the website. This is a work in progress and will continue to evolve as we move forward. A hit counter has been added to keep track of visits from the homepage.

Items started and in the works:

- Requested a quote from Encompassit (the IT company the Municipality uses) for 3 public computers.
- Assembling items for the small business hardgoods toolkit.
- The meeting room application form has been updated to include requests for virtual and/or hybrid meeting space. The paper newsletter will be promoting this (when it gets out!) and we will also start leveraging our social media channels.
