CEMC, Frank Loeffen called the Emergency Management Control Group Meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

There was no formal agenda prepared for this meeting. This meeting was to give an update to the committee and to advise how the municipality will prepare regarding the announcement of the Provincial Emergency Declaration made by Premier Ford on January 12th, 2021. The Declaration took effect immediately and effective January 14th, 2021 at 12:01 am, the strict regulations to start (stay at home, no necessary outings, no necessary travel, etc.). Premier Ford advised that the Declaration is up to February 10th, 2021, 11:59 p.m. Everyone that have accommodations to work from home, must stay home.

Outcome of the CEMC meeting:

- Recreation facilities - rink is closed;
- Municipal Office will be closed to the public. Doors will remain locked to the public. Basically, we are returning to the same as we did in the spring of 2020 with the first declaration;
- Media information will be prepared and be posted on municipal website;
- Public Works will continue their work schedule as needed. Landfill site will remain open. Staff is required to always wear their proper PPE, inside and outside;
- F/D is essential services and will continue with training as usual and abide by the implemented rules and regulations;
- The Library is only open to curbside pickup;
- OPP advised that they will be monitoring gatherings, etc. OPP will share media received from the Solicitor General's office with the Municipality to share on our social media;
- Staff advised to stay at home where possible and avoid un-necessary travels and outings.
