  due to COVID the date has changed. We are waiting on new date
- The PSB is still working with the deadline date of January 2021 still lots of work to do
  on the plan
- PSB will be looking at preparing a Survey to reach out to the residents of the municipality in order to receive their concerns/comments pertaining to the Plan.
- S/Sgt. McMullen advised that Mr. Garry Fay has worked with the Gateway Hub in North Bay to develop their plan. Mattawa and Bonfield has retained his services for assisting in their plan as well. Garry would be an excellent person to assist in preparation of questions for survey and outlining highlights of our plan. S/Sgt. McMullen advised that he would be a good resource for the municipality. S/Sgt. McMullen to send his contact info to Monica - At our quarterly meeting scheduled for December 10th, 2020, a recommendation will be prepared for Council to engage the services of Garry Fay for assistance in the CSWBP
- OPP will be releasing a video: "Safeguard Ontario" They advised to share on social media
- An action item for our plan Project Life Saver Equipment with transmitter. The cost is in the average of \$10,000 \$12,000. This could be a project where the Club Action 50+ would like to take on
- OPP is doing a special campaign on Enforcement of Speed
