THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF EAST FERRIS

BY-LAW NO. 2020-32

BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT A MUNICIPAL LAW ENFORCEMENT OFFICER AS AUTHORIZED UNDER THE PROVISIONS OF THE POLICE SERVICES ACT.

WHEREAS Section 15 of the Police Services Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.15 provides that council of a municipality may appoint persons to enforce the by-laws of the municipality and such municipal law enforcement officers are peace officers for the purpose of enforcing municipal by-laws;

AND WHEREAS pursuant to Section 1 of the Provincial Offences Act, R.S.O. 1990, Chapter P.33, the Attorney General of Ontario has designated municipal law enforcement officers as provincial offences officers to enforce the by-laws of the municipality under the Provincial Offences Act;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of East Ferris deems it desirable and expedient to appoint a Municipal Law Enforcement Officer to enforce the by-laws of the Municipality;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of East Ferris enacts as follows:

- That Paul Gervais be hereby appointed as a Municipal Law Enforcement
 Officer for the Corporation of the Municipality of East Ferris for so long as he
 continues to be employed by the Corporation.
- 2. That Paul Gervais shall hold office at the pleasure and subject to the by-laws of the Municipality of East Ferris, and shall, with respect to the Municipality of East Ferris and the enforcement of its by-laws, exercise all the authority, powers and rights, and shall perform all the duties and obligations which by statue or by-law or may be conferred or imposed upon a Provincial Offences Officer.
- 3. That any Municipal by-law that conflicts with this by-law shall be hereby repealed.
- 4. That this by-law shall come into force and effect on the date of it finally passed.
