






Keynote: Disasters - Leadership Before, During, and After, *Presented by Jamie Coutts*

As a result of that horrific incident, Carl lost his gig with The Guess Who. Carl will discuss his remarkable come back from his car crash and hear how he rebuilt his personal life and business to enter the happiest and busiest phase of his life.
