- 1. Agenda Agenda was approved as prepared
- 2. Minutes of previous meeting October 15th, 2019 (Minutes circulated to Council on agenda of October 22nd, 2019.) Committee was OK as per minutes circulated to Council agenda of October 22nd, 2019.
- 3. **Declarations of Conflict of Interest –** None for this session
- 4. Correspondence and Information Items:
 - a) Update on Speed Watch Sign Public Works Foreman advised that the sign had not been posted; Public Works will set it up and give it a test run before the winter weather sets in.
 - **b) Update on trucks** The plow truck will be road ready on Friday (this week) and the ³/₄ ton is in transit, should be here within 2 weeks
 - c) Spring clean-up day Discussion regarding clean-up day (earth day). Committee is looking at dates: April 25, May 9th. For clean up day, bags will be provided. Bags will be identified in special color and marking of East Ferris. The reason is to monitor of waste that was picked up and to make sure that we are not collecting residential garbage. Depot sights will be set up for this day
 - d) Garbage and Recycling Contract with R & D. Agreement states that contract can be renewed for another term if both parties agree prior to February 2020 Director provided committee with report from the current contract. Agreement states that it can be renewed for another 2 years. Committee felt that it would be best to renew for the term of 2 years. R & D is also in favour of renewing
 - e) E-mail from Danny Gervais regarding his pit. In discussing with Mr. Gervais, it only pertains to his pit. Director will be contacting MNRF regarding pit before further discussions take place
 - f) Antoine to discuss the following:
 - Booth Road Discussion of making road a one way. Public Works would be contacting residents on this road with the possibility of implementing in the Spring.
 - Turgeon Lane access to boat ramp on South Shore Road
 - Cedar Bay turnaround
 - Information regarding the transition period of the Blue Box
