BY-LAW NO. 2019-53

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NO. 2220 A BY-LAW TO ADOPT AN EMERGENCY PLAN.

WHEREAS Section 3(1) of the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act R.S.O. 1990, Chapter E.9 states that every municipality shall formulate an emergency plan governing the provision of necessary services during an emergency and the procedures under the manner in which employees of the municipality and other persons will respond to the emergency and the Council of the municipality shall by By-law adopt the emergency plan;

AND WHEREAS Section 4(1) of the Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act R.S.O. 1990, Chapter E.9 states that the head of Council of a municipality may declare that an emergency exists in the municipality or in any part thereof and may take such actions and make such orders as he or she considers necessary and are not contrary to law to implement the emergency plan of the municipality and to protect property and the health, safety and welfare of the inhabitants of the emergency area;

NOW THEREFORE the Council for the Corporation of the Municipality of East Ferris ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. That article 3 of schedule "A" of By-law No. 2220 "COMPOSITION OF THE COMMUNITY CONTROL GROUP FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF EAST FERRIS" be deleted in its entirety and replaced as follows:
 - 3.0 COMPOSITION OF THE EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT PROGRAM COMMITTEE & COMPOSITION OF THE MUNICIPAL EMERGENCY CONTROL GROUP.
 - 3.1(1) Composition of the Emergency Management Program Committee
 The Municipal Emergency Management Program Committee is the group
 responsible for conducting an annual review of the Municipality's Emergency
 Management Program and shall make recommendations to the Council for its
 revision if necessary. The composition of the Committee is as follows:
 - Mayor or their Alternate;
 - Chief Administrative Officer or their Alternate;
 - Fire Chief/CEMC or their Alternate;
 - EIO or their Alternate;
 - Director of Public Works or their Alternate:
 - Treasurer or their Alternate:
 - · Chief Building Official or their Alternate.

3.1(2) Composition of the Municipal Emergency Control Group

Not all members of the Municipal Emergency Control Group have to be present at the EOC to function and therefore, may function with only a limited number of persons depending upon the nature of the emergency. In addition, an emergency does not have to be declared to have the group activated. Emergency response operations will be directed and controlled by the following officials or their alternates at an Emergency Operations Centre:

- Mayor
- Chief Administrative Officer
- Scribe
- Fire Chief
- Community Emergency Management Coordinator
- Director of Public Works
- Emergency Information Officer
- Treasurer
