### **BACKGROUND**

This report provides information on the annual activities of the East Ferris Fire Department for 2018.

For Council's information, an average response time analysis including the average number of personnel and staff hours from January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2018 to December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018 is also provided.

In 2018, the Fire Department responded to 164 emergency calls with an estimated dollar loss of \$243,100.

The department had a total of 9 fire responses of the 164 emergency calls.

- 2 calls (1%) were classed as structure fires; 1 house and 1 electrical fire in a house with minor damage for an estimated loss of \$223,100.
- 1 call (1%) was a vehicle fire with an estimated loss of \$20,000.
- 2 calls (1%): 1 camper trailer fire and 1 call to a fire at our landfill site both with no dollar loss.
- 4 outdoor fire responses with no loss (2%) grass and hydro pole fires with no dollar loss.

The Department also responded to **155 non-fire calls** that accounted for 95% of the Department's responses in 2018. The number of responses and the percentage breakdown are as follows:

- 6 False fire calls or alarms reported by monitoring companies (4%)
- 93 Medical / resuscitator calls (57%)
- 19 Other responses, cancelled calls or perceived emergencies (12%)
- 4 Pre-fire conditions with no fire including equipment over heating (2%)
- 9 Public hazard calls, gas leaks, downed hydro lines (5%)
- 16 Rescues including motor vehicle collisions, ice / water and off road responses (10%).

The Department responded to 5 Mutual Aid Assistance calls in 2018 as follows:

- 1 in Bonfield
- 2 in Callander
- 2 in Chisholm

The Department also conducted 68 sessions which include training, equipment maintenance, meetings and public events. The number of sessions does not include inspection of residential or commercial properties.

A 6-year comparison on the number of incidents by group type and total annual emergency calls from January 1<sup>st</sup>, 2013 to December 31<sup>st</sup>, 2018 is provided for Council's information.

Also provided is the 2018 Standard Incident Report Verification Summary that has been reviewed and submitted to the Office of the Fire Marshal. The Standard Incident Report details the total calls, the percentage of the total, the total calls per month and the dollar losses.

The members of the East Ferris Fire Department continue to conduct door to door smoke alarm inspections, public education events and school visits as our provincially mandated public education and prevention program.

### CONCLUSION

As the Fire Chief, I am very proud of the members who have committed to their skills and knowledge training. Their dedication has been reflected in the protection and assistance to residents and visitors of our community. Their professional attitude and presentation to the public has been demonstrated in their efficiencies when responding to a call for help.


