Request for Digital Video and Photography Services

January 14th 2019

The Municipality of East Ferris has a \$4,000 budget (to include taxes) to produce a short 5 minute video. The video project is entitled "New Municipal Office Business Case." We are interested in your services to produce the video, given your listing in the Three Best Rated videographers for North Bay. The video will be used to illustrate the business case for a new municipal office when meeting with influencers, lenders and government officials. It will highlight all of the current building problems and why it has been declared obsolete. The final product you provide must be in a form that is easy to load and play on a laptop or an I Pad. It must not be too slick or polished but engaging and somewhat fast paced.

The video is required by Friday, February 12th 2019. While the precise script will be finalized with you on January 25th, the Municipality will supply a draft list of topics, suggested cast and casting locations as per Appendix A. Also included in Appendix A is a tentative schedule.

The budget includes converting the script into a workplan, story boards (can be verbal), scheduling, shooting / filming, post production editing, addition of animations / sub-titles, mileage, food, lighting, equipment, setup, crew and photographs. All materials to be completed and remitted to the Municipality of East Ferris will be the sole property of the Municipality. The Municipality will agree to provide a deposit in the amount specified and the payment balance will be owed 30 days following February 12th, 2019.
