#### 11. Other Business

a) Municipal Events & Activities Calendar: The Director of Community Services introduced the 2024 work plan, a plan of current municipal events and potential for additional annual events for planning continuity.

The Committee discussed options for Canada Day/St. Jean Baptiste Day, a summer or fall family fun day, and additional support to the East Ferris Carnival.

It was noted that a public event will be scheduled for Volunteer Appreciation Week, April  $14^{th} - 20^{th}$ , 2024.

Refinements will be made to the Municipal Events and Activities Calendar and be brought forward to the next meeting of the Committee, specifically Participaction and Canada Day.

b) MacPherson/Centennial Trail Development Plan: The Director of Community Services advised that a piece of land was acquired through a plan of subdivision between One Mile Road and Centennial Crescent that could potentially be developed as a connecting trail to MacPherson as part of the Active Transportation Plan. It was also noted that funding has been secured for road shoulder development on Centennial Crescent and MacPherson Drive. The Committee agreed that this project should be examined and passed the following resolution:

THAT the Parks, Recreation and Culture Committee recommends to Council that the municipality examine the opportunity of providing a connecting walkway between One Mile Road and Centennial Crescent across the municipally owned parkland in conjunction with the broader active transportation plan along Centennial Crescent and MacPherson Drive.
