## THE CORPORATION OF THE MUNICIPALITY OF EAST FERRIS

## BY-LAW NO. 2023-39

## BEING A BY-LAW TO APPOINT A LOTTERY LICENSING OFFICER FOR THE MUNICIPALITY OF EAST FERRIS

**WHEREAS** the Criminal Code (Canada) provides that the provinces may license certain lottery schemes;

**AND WHEREAS** the Lieutenant Governor in Council of Ontario or such other person or authority who the Lieutenant Governor in Council may specify is authorized under the Criminal Code (Canada) to issue or cause to be issued licences to charitable or religious organizations for the purpose of conducting and managing lottery schemes in Ontario;

**AND WHEREAS** the Lieutenant Governor in Council pursuant to Section 2 of Order in Council 1413/08 states that a municipal council may, if it deems it to be in the best interests of the inhabitants of the municipality, issue or cause to be issued, a licence authorizing a charitable organization to conduct and manage the types of lottery schemes as may be specified by the Registrar and approved by the Minister;

**AND WHEREAS** the Lieutenant Governor in Council pursuant to Section 3 of Order in Council 1413/08 states that despite section 2, a municipal council may only issue a licence or authorization if, issuing the licence or authorization is consistent with the Registrar's requirements; the proceeds from the lottery scheme will be used for a charitable object or purpose providing a direct benefit to the residents of Ontario; and the proposed event will be conducted in accordance with the Gaming Control Act, 1992 and its regulations;

**AND WHEREAS** the Council of the Municipality of East Ferris deems it expedient to appoint a Lottery Licensing Officer for purposes of issuing Lottery Licenses in the Municipality of East Ferris;

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council of Corporation of the Municipality of East Ferris enacts as follows:

- 1. That the Municipal Clerk or their designate be appointed as the Lottery Licensing Officer for the Municipality of East Ferris.
- 2. That this appointment shall become effective upon its passing; and
- 3. That By-law No. 2015-28 be repealed.
